

Campaign Poster

Poster requirements:

1. You must do a rough draft on notebook paper first. After it is approved, do a final draft on the larger paper provided. The final draft must be very colorful.
2. Your poster should be a combination of “catchy” slogan and eye-catching drawings (hand-drawn by you).

Slogans usually comment on the candidate or an issue that your party is proposing or supporting. They can also be on good qualities possessed.

Some examples from real campaigns:

“Keep cool with Coolidge!”

“I like Ike!”

“A chicken in every pot!”

“We’re fine with PT109!”

“Tippicanoe and Tyler too!”

3. In addition to a “catchy” slogan and drawings, your poster must include the candidate’s name and the office for which they are running.
