3 - VIRGINIA DECLARATION OF RIGHTS	Written by George Mason. Major state document. Must agree with the U.S. Constitution.
4 - DECLARATION OF INDEPENDENCE	First ten amendments to the U.S. Constitution. Written by James Madison. Gives people their individual rights.
5 - VA STATUTE OF RELIGIOUS FREEDOM	Written so the rights of Englishmen would be given to the colonists, like at Jamestown.
6 - ARTICLES OF CONFEDERATION	Written by Thomas Jefferson. Provides for freedom of religion in VA.
	Written by George Mason. Later used as a model for the U.S. Bill of Rights.
7 - VIRGINIA CONSTITUTION	Written by James Madison. Sets up the government we have today. 3 branches, shared power, majority rules.
8 - UNITED STATES CONSTITUTION	Loose cooperation of states. First government, could not enforce laws or make states pay taxes. It did not work.
