

 The Lieutenant Governor serves as the President of the Senate of Virginia and is first in the line of succession to the governor; in the event the governor dies, resigns, or otherwise leaves office, the lieutenant governor becomes

> The Attorney General provides legal advice to the state government, and defends the state in criminal and civil cases.

• Both are executive branch officers who are elected for a 4-year term of office.
